

# Activities & working report, February 2009

### <u>Activities, February:</u>

#### 1) <u>The construction went on for full scale in February.</u>

As explained in the revised budget, many unforeseen expenses exceeded the budget. The unforeseen expenses were:

- 1. Leveling the construction site with soil. This was an unforeseen expense of 40,000 Bhat.
- **2. Construction of 2 teachers' apartments with bathrooms attached.** This exceeded the budget with around 100,000 Bhat. Due to the construction of the additional teachers' apartments, the construction team requested another 20,000 Bhat in addition to the 60,000 Bhat first agreed on for allowances.
- **3. Price of iron for the school construction.** The school construction required more iron than first expected and with the rapid changes of iron this was also an extra unforeseen expense.
- 4. Some wood was also added to the school building without prior price estimate.

#### 3) Made a revised budget

The current expenses due to pay on the school building exceeds the original budget with (shockingly) 200,000 Bhat. Some construction changes were totally unexpected (leveling the construction site); other changes (adding the teachers' apartments) were made after the first budget was written. The revised budget was submitted to Asian Leadership, Tuesday 24/02/09.

### 4) Set further standards for the Schools of Hope accounting

After some trying and failing, we've decided on a suggestion for an accounting method which we feel will work well for the project: Noom Hkurh will do the daily accounting based on the funding transferred from Asian Leadership. Lisa will do the overall overseeing of the accounting and help do the monthly accounting and reports. Each receipt will be copied as well as the bank book and the hand written accounting Noom is doing. Lisa does the accounting on an Excel sheet, which will all be submitted to Asian Leadership monthly. We hope for further feed-back from Asian Leadership soon.

## **Difficulties encountered:**

1. <u>The over-exceeded budget.</u> We realize that all the changes with the accounting could bring our credibility to question.

<u>2. The rapid construction process.</u> The construction team completed most of the construction before sufficient funding was available. We have now put all construction to a halt until further funding is available. Below is an overview of the remaining expenses due to be paid. Copies of the bills due to pay will be handed over to Asian Leadership on March  $2^{nd}$ .
